Frequently Asked Questions

What is the Maternity Management Program?

The Maternity Management Program is a voluntary program that provides expectant mothers with the guidance and support needed for a healthy pregnancy. This confidential program partners you with a Maternity Registered Nurse who will support you and serve as an educational resource. The program is also customized to fit your individual health needs.

How did you get my name?

Based on your claims history, your physician has indicated you are an expecting mom. You may also self-enroll into the Maternity Management Program by calling the number on your Benefit ID card or emailing mycoach@imagine360.com.

Will you share my personal health information with anyone?

The program is completely confidential and is compliant with federal privacy regulations (HIPAA). Your information is shared only with you and your doctor. Your employer will not see any personal information.

If I choose to participate in the program, what can I expect and how often will I be contacted?

If you choose to participate in this program, your Maternity Registered Nurse will contact you at least once a month to discuss your health goals, concerns and any barriers. Your nurse will also answer any questions regarding pregnancy, delivery, and caring for your new baby.

How long is the Maternity Management program?

Participants are enrolled in the program through the duration of pregnancy plus six weeks postpartum.

When will the nurse call?

You and your Maternity Registered Nurse can set up a time that is most convenient and comfortable for you. Appointments can be after normal business hours or on weekends. You can also communicate with your nurse by phone or by email whenever you have questions. Monday - Thursday: 8:00 - 7:00 p.m., Friday: 8:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m. and Saturdays by appointment.

Participation in this program is optional and you can change your level of participation anytime.
