AVAILABLE SCHOLARSHIPS

Fifteen (15) scholarships are offered:

- Each for a maximum of \$3,000 annually
- Up to four consecutive years for a college/university
- Up to two consecutive years for a trade school

WHO CAN APPLY?

- Children of full-time employees who plan to attend college/trade school as an entering freshman this fall. This includes:
 - High school seniors who will graduate this spring
 - High school graduates who have not started their college/trade school program



- Applicants must pursue:
 - Any course of study leading to one of the usual baccalaureate degrees in a college or university, -or-
 - A diploma for a completed course of study in a trade school
- Children of Officers, Division Presidents, Vice Presidents, A/DPs (as well as Division Sales/Service Managers), Region Managers, and Rollins Support Center Directors are not eligible to apply.



SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be judged on the basis of their grades, Scholastic Aptitude Test (SAT) or American College Test (ACT) scores (if applicable), GPA, financial need, and involvement in civic or extracurricular activities. Other criteria may also be considered, such as the parent's length of employment with the company and counselor recommendations.
